

Steps to Apply and Accept Financial Aid:

1. Create your FSA ID at fsaid.ed.gov. You'll need your FSA ID to sign your FAFSA during the application process.
2. Apply for aid by submitting a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) found at fafsa.ed.gov.
3. If you are selected for a review process called **verification**, you will be asked to submit an **Institutional Verification Worksheet** and tax return transcripts. The worksheet is available at osfa.tamucc.edu. Submit all documents as soon as possible. Processing could take two to three weeks and longer during peak periods.
4. Receive award notification. Award information will be posted on a student's SAIL account, and all award notifications will be sent to the student's official University email address.
5. Complete loan entrance counseling. Counseling is required for students who take out loans. Instructions are available at osfa.tamucc.edu/guarantee_loan.html. You must complete and sign the Master Promissory Note before loan funds can be disbursed. Loan entrance counseling will be offered during New Student Orientation.
6. Receive financial aid. Financial aid is normally disbursed directly to the Business Office, prior to the first day of classes or tuition deadline. NOTE: All first-year, first-time borrowers must wait 30 days after the semester has started before receiving their loan funds. Specific disbursement date by financial aid type can be found at osfa.tamucc.edu/get_money.html.
